## Graduate Program in Physics



The Graduate Program in Physics at Georgetown University offers students the opportunity to take part in multidisciplinary research at an internationally renowned institution. Students benefit from close guidance from professors and gain real-world experience through the department's partnerships in industry, which include IBM, Procter & Gamble, Areté Associates, and Luna Innovations.

Graduate students choose from two courses of study. Those interested in the traditional path complete advanced physics coursework, followed

by thesis research. Students can also join the Industrial Leadership in Physics (ILP) program. ILP students supplement their physics coursework with business classes and a year-long industrial apprenticeship.

There are also many opportunities for graduate physics students in the Washington, D.C. area, including government research laboratories and large corporate research laboratories.
